

DANISH SURF TOUR 2024

TERMS AND CONDITIONS



1. Introduction

- 1.1. These Terms and Conditions shall be binding on you, when entering any competitions on the DANISH SURF TOUR which includes all Open events in all series, including jam events.

2. Eligibility & Entry

- 2.1. All events on the Danish Surf Tour is open for all nationalities to enter and participate.
- 2.2. You may not enter a competition if, on the date it is announced, you do not conform to the required profile of the entrant. For example, a division may be limited by age.
- 2.3. All entries must be received by DANISH SURF TOUR by the closing date specified in the competition. The registration can also be closed when the participation limit is reached.
- 2.4. It is per default not possible to enter the competition after the registration is closed. In some cases Surf & SUP Danmark or the Head Judge can make an exception to the matter.
- 2.5. Entry fees can only be paid through the LiveHeats system.

3. Refunds

- 3.1. If a competition is cancelled by the DANISH SURF TOUR, the registered participants gets full refunds of their entry fees.

3.2. If a participant doesn't show up on competition day or cancel his/her participation after the event has been called ON, the participant will not get any refunds.

4. Decisions

4.1 All decisions of the DANISH SURF TOUR will be final and binding.

5. Contest

5.1. DANISH SURF TOUR does not accept responsibility for entries lost, damaged or delayed in transit to the competition address. Proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of receipt (nor will proof that an email has been sent be accepted as proof it has been received).

5.2. The decision of DANISH SURF TOUR's judges is final and conclusive in all circumstances.

5.3. If a participant wants to make a protest for a specific heat during the contest, he/she shall go to the Beach Marshall within 20 min after the heat is finished. After that, the competition will be on hold until the HJ and Beach Marshall have discussed the case. A judging scoring decision once made is irrevocable, useless if the HJ and Beach Marshall notice a mistake in the general procedure of the specific heat. Video evidence can be used to clarify a potential mistake. (Inspired by ISA & WSL guidelines). A deposit of 250 DKK has to be paid due to a protest, if the protest is accepted by HJ and Beach Marshall you will get a full refund.

5.4 If a surfer fails to show for his/hers first heat of the competition, then the surfer will be out for the rest of the competition without the possibility of going to the repechage and be given zero points.

5.5 All competitors must show up for the Skippers meeting. The time and place for the Skippers meeting will be announced the day before the competition. If a surfer fails to show for the Skippers meeting, then the surfer will be out for the rest of the competition

5.6 An event is typically scheduled to run over a weekend to complete all categories, but the event team will aim towards completing the event in one day. In the case that the wave conditions become unsurfable midst the competition, the event will be called OFF and scores will not count towards the championship. Head Judge has the right to overrule this, if needed.

5.7 DANISH SURF TOUR consists of three series: a Shortboard series, a Longboard series and a Juniors Series. To secure the best possible surfing conditions and qualified judging team the Shortboard, Longboard and Juniors will be held as separate competitions. The Shortboard Open will contain of 3 stops, Longboard Open of 2 stops and Juniors 2 stops. Furthermore there will be held a Jam event that doesn't count towards the championship.

6. Rankings in Danish Surf Tour & Danish Championship

6.1 The winners of each category in the different series on the DANISH SURF TOUR is based on the best overall score collected through the amount of events held throughout the season in each series. The maximum of OPEN stops in a series, will typically be three, but can vary from year to year, with a minimum of one stop.

6.2 DANISH SURF TOUR also holds the official Danish Championship in surfing (DM). A person with a foreign passport can't become Danish Champion, but can win the DANISH SURF TOUR title as explained above in 6.1. The winner of each category in the different series is based on the best overall score collected throughout the events in the series.

6.3 DANISH SURF TOUR also holds the JUNIOR TOUR which will have 2 event stops each year. The winners of each category is based on the best overall score collected through the amount of events held throughout the season. Only Danish juniors (U18) can be crowned Danish Champion.

6.4. Due to regulatives by The National Olympic Committee & Sports Confederation of Denmark (DIF) specific categories are officially approved as Danish Championships and some categories don't fulfill the requirements yet: Approved categories (Receiving DIF-medals): Shortboard Men, Shortboard Women, Longboard Men and Longboard Women. Non-approved categories (Receiving Surf & SUP Denmark-medals) are Junior (all categories).

7. Health and Safety

7.1. You confirm and warrant that to the best of your knowledge your general state of health is good and you have no medical condition that could be adversely affected by strenuous exercise or any of the events or activities planned or reasonably expected to be involved in the competition.

7.2. All activities are undertaken at your own risk. You must notify DANISH SURF TOUR of any medical or other condition which may mean that you are unfit for participation in a contest as soon as you become aware of such a condition.

7.3 You must have the necessary skills to take care of yourself in the water. The DANISH SURF TOUR will pick competition spots that offer the best waves for competition. If a surfer does not feel comfortable to compete at the selected break, it is their own responsibility to step down from the competition, and take care of their own safety, in and out of the water.

8.Prizes

8.1. Prizes are not transferable, must (where applicable) be used on the dates specified and may not be redeemed for cash.

8.2 Whenever DM winners at an event are receiving prize money, it will be the same amount for women and men. Juniors will, as a standard, not be given prize money.

9. Publicity

9.1 Competitors may be required by DANISH SURF TOUR to participate in a photo, video and/or film session, and acknowledge that DANISH SURF TOUR has the right to use such publicity photos, videos and/or films in any medium and in any reasonable manner it sees fit, unless that person informs DANISH SURF TOUR at the time of entering the competition that he or she wishes to retain his or her anonymity

9.2 Contest entries and material submitted in connection with any contest (whether in written, audio, electronic or visual form, or any combination of those) or any photographs, video and/or film footage and/or audio recording taken of competitors become the property of DANISH SURF TOUR, which may use the material in any medium and in any reasonable manner it sees fit. Copyright in any such material remains the sole property of DANISH SURF TOUR.

10. Jurisdiction

10.1 DANISH SURF TOUR may change these Terms and Conditions at any time.
